Topic: ARTIFACTS - Things You See That Aren't There & Things You Don't See That Are!

Description:

An unavoidable consequence of the use of ultrasound is the production of artifacts. These can be manifested by creating an illusion of an object that is not really there, or masking an object that is present. 2-D and Doppler imaging each have their own unique artifacts. This presentation will serve to demonstrate and explore many of the common artifacts cardiac sonographers should be familiar with.

- Understand the causes and significance of sonographic artifacts
- Identify common sources of artifacts in 2-D imaging
- Recognize some common Doppler artifacts and their implications
- Review basic techniques to confirm and troubleshoot suspected artifacts

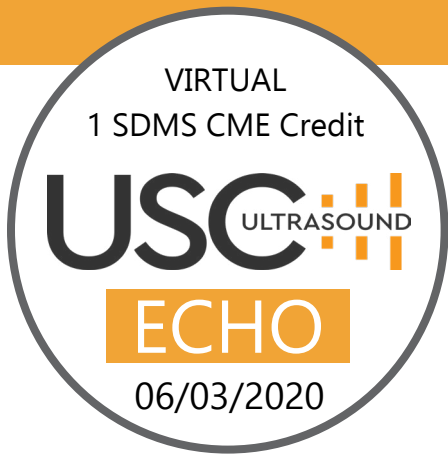
