Topic: Ultrasound of Renal Transplants (Approved for 1 SDMS CME credit)

Description:

Renal transplantation is the best treatment option for patients with end-stage renal disease, and is the most common type of transplant performed today. Sonography is the imaging modality of choice for evaluating renal transplants for anatomic complications, perinephric fluid collections, vascular compromise, and signs of rejection. This seminar will review anatomy of the transplanted kidney, scanning protocol, and complications that may arise. Representative normal and abnormal sonographic images will be used to describe and explain various findings.

- Specify the sonographic appearance of the transplanted kidney, including position, location, and anastomoses

About Our Speaker:



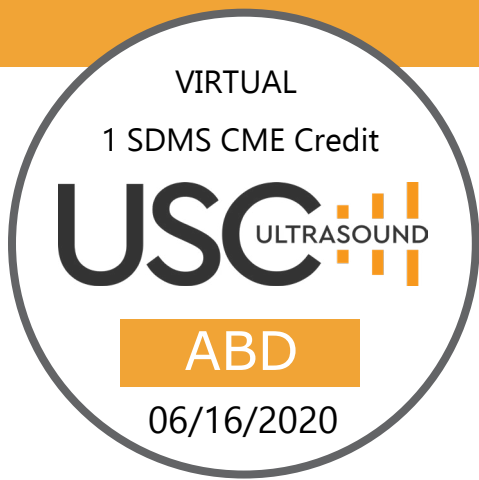
